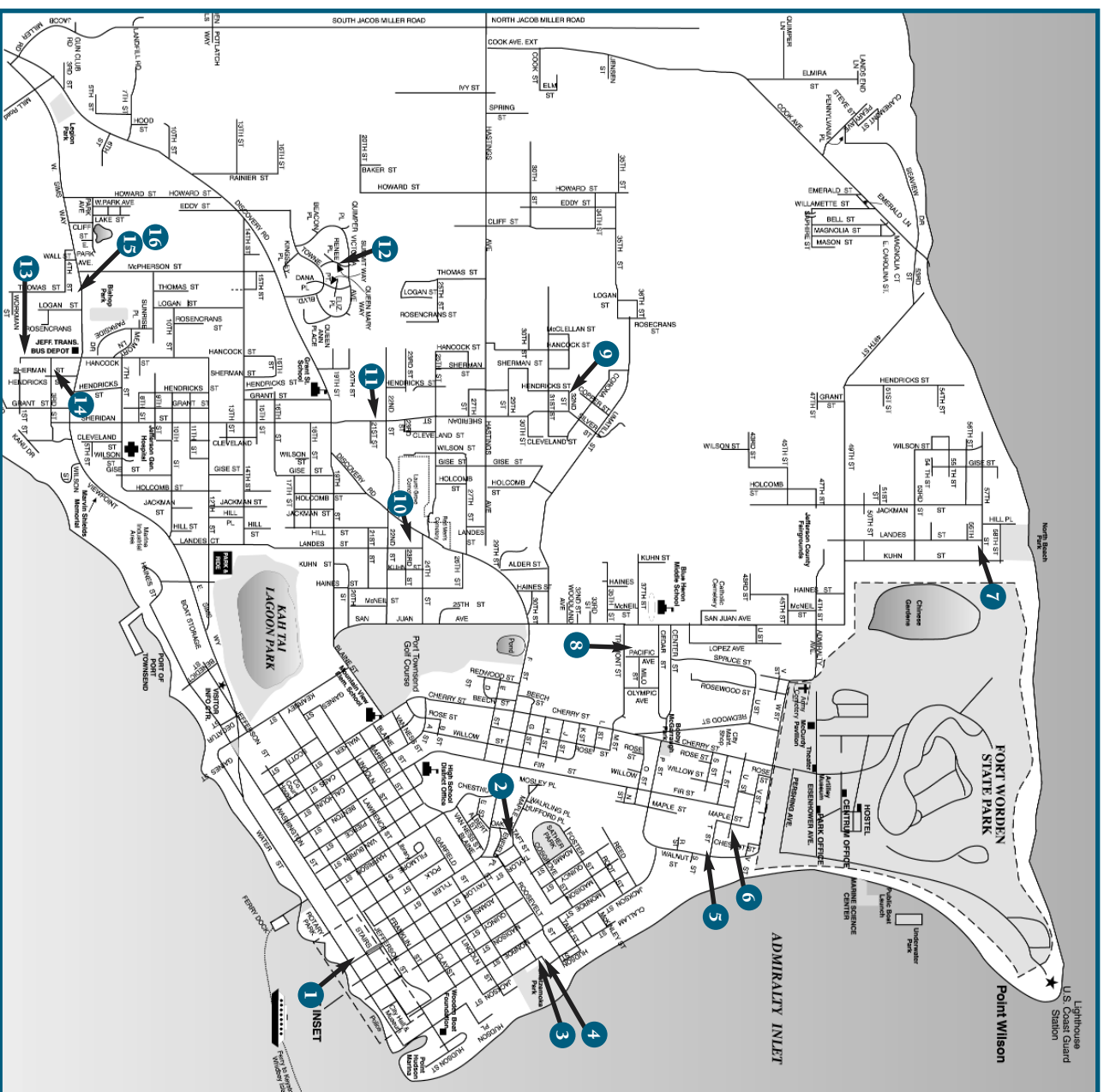

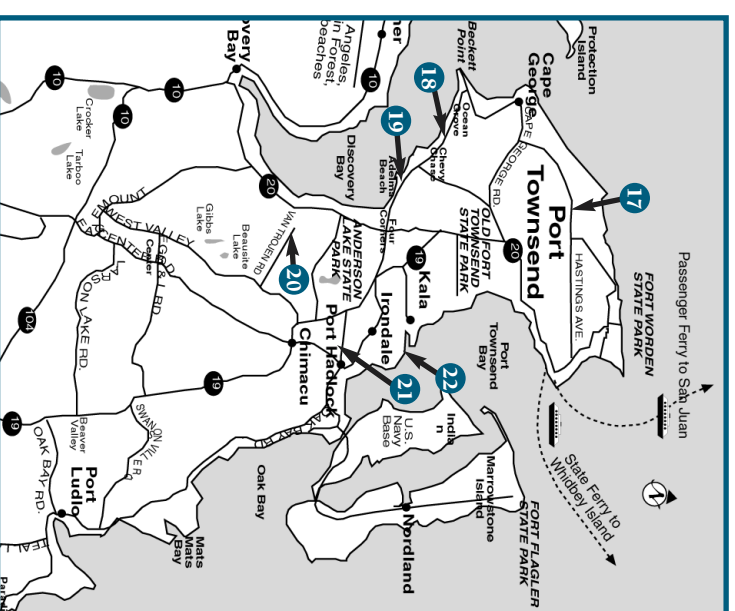


Welcome to Art Route, a self-guided tour of art studios in Port Townsend and Jefferson County. With this brochure you will be able to find studios of twenty two working artists, each of whom represents a unique type of visual art. You'll find a map and a brief paragraph about the artist and the art you will see, the address, phone, and where relevant, the e-mail address of each artist. A sign marks the studio location corresponding to the number on the map. Drive around the County following the map to studios during their designated hours. Because artists are sometimes out of their studios, it's a good idea to phone ahead.

The Jefferson Arts Alliance is a tax exempt, non-profit corporation dedicated to promoting the arts in Jefferson County. Among its programs are Art Port Townsend and the Northwind Arts Center. The Port Townsend Arts Commission is a city funded agency that sponsors numerous arts programs.

It is recommended to phone artists for complete directions, to verify open studio times or to make a special appointment.
